
About Holistic Kids Foundation

Our activities are personalized, original, and educational.







Our Story


Holistic Kids Foundation was founded inTarragona, Spain, 2002. Our mission was to teach children with special needs new tools and perspectives to enrich their daily lives.

We visited hospitals, education centers, and foster care facilities to Barcelona and back, instilling joy and positivity in these underserved children.

After our work with children was met with overwhelmingly positive reception, we expanded our program and mission to include senior citizens in our efforts to spread joy and positivity.

We strengthened our ties to local hospitals and continued to work with young and old alike until our 2014 relocation to the United States, where we re-established HKF in LA.

We then collaborated with the McDonalds Charity House and other American non-profit associations in efforts to continue spreading our practice.

The HMK Project is a series of interactive techniques and workshops that we use to teach children and adults wellness in a Holistic and Integral way, covering all aspects of life:

the Body, Mind, Heart, and Spirit.

These activities connect children with their Body's needs, to creatively express their Heart's emotions and desires, to release the blocked traumas of the subconscious Mind.

Sensory experiences and assisted meditation to restore Spiritual balance by bringing children to a closer understanding of and connection to the Earth, Society, and their places therein.

We apply our holistic approach to a variety of activities in creative expression, including art, music, dance, and even working with animals.

Past Iterations

Miami, Florida- 2020

'The Tree of Life,' a creative outlet project by which children from complicated homes build tree sculptures to personify and reflect on their chosen families and ancestors.

'Message of Life,' a workshop in unblocking one's innermost emotions to communicate them effectively to the world.

'Dance of the Tribes,' a hands-on immersion in multicultural song and dance from native tribes around the world with emphasis on re-connecting with one's spiritual roots and world cultures.

'Leave Your Mark,' a series of mural art projects by which participants contribute to the beautification of their communities through creative expression and collaboration.




